Step 4: Cleaning & Charging





Before returning Ring Cutter to the case, clean **Finger Guard** groove with the provided cleaning tool.

Wipe the device clean with 70% isopropyl alcohol or 0.5% accelerated hydrogen peroxide wipes.



After cleaning, plug-in Ring Cutter and charge for next use.

Troubleshooting & Indicators







- **DO NOT** force the cutting disc into the ring. Allow the Ring Cutter to cut automatically.
- Avoid excessive motion during
- DO NOT use Open/Close Buttons



Improper Use (flashing amber)



flash, pause cutting and resolve the issue. The Ring Cutter will stop cutting for 10 seconds if improper use continues. Cutting can resume after **amber lights** have cleared.

Examples of improper use:

- Insufficient lubrication
- Moving or maneuvering the Ring Cutter during cutting
- Forcing the cutting disc into the ring



When the battery level becomes critically low, the device will disable

the Trigger, but will still allow the Open/Close Buttons to operate.



Step 1: Setup & Startup



Regularly monitor ring temperature during cut. If ring is warm, add lubricant or pause cutting. Use only between 10 - 25°C (50 - 77°F) imbient temperature.

Hold Open Button to open Finger Guard.

Step 2: Ring Cutting Operation



Position the patient's hand and the Ring Cutter on a flat, stable surface. A typical ring takes **3 - 6 minutes** to cut.

The Ring Cutter can cut rings up to US size 13.5 - For tips cutting uncommon rings, see Technical Reference.





Insert Finger Guard under the ring until ring touches the rear of

Hold the Close Button to close the Finger Guard until the disc touches the ring.







Pull **Trigger** to begin cutting. The Ring Cutter will cut the ring automatically! Monitor your progress with the **Progress** Indicator.

The Lubrication Reminder will periodically flash blue during cutting. Apply 2 sprays of Ring Lubricant to the disc when indicated. You can continue cutting while applying the Ring Lubricant.

Step 3: Completing A Cut



Expect

3 - 6 minutes cutting time for standard size rings.





The Progress Indicator will flash green when cut is complete. Hold the Open **Button** to remove **Finger Guard** from under the ring.
